COMMITTEE REPORTS

Membership

In our first year, the AWGC contacted 180 potential members, family and friends of the three founders, and invited them to share our mission of improving the lives of women and children in the Albuquerque community. With only this targeted approach of asking friends and family, and with no social media other than our website, we had 55 women become members. Through our membership fees, and other donations from women supportive of our cause but unable to become full members, we were able to raise \$15,695.00.

Grants Committee

The AWGC Grants Committee was formed in March 2021 with seven members. As it was the first year of the AWGC, the committee worked hard to create the structure for the granting process. The committee set a timeline, wrote the Request for Proposals (RFP), created a distribution list to share the RFP, created a scoring rubric, reviewed the applications, presented the process and applicants to the membership, and conducted the vote to decide on the grantees. The committee also spent time after the first cycle to reflect on the process and make recommendations for 2022. In total, the committee reviewed six applications and the membership decided to award two organizations, Crossroads for Women and Enlace Comunitario.



GRANTEE UPDATES

Enlace Comunitario

As we all wrap up another pandemic-shaped year, Enlace has experienced a 25% increase in clients from 2020—with survivors reporting an increase in the severity and frequency of domestic violence. AWGC's support has helped us meet clients' emergency requests for transitional housing, household goods, and other life-enhancing services. With this uptick in violence, we are especially grateful for change-making partners like AWGC, whose generous support has helped us serve over 850 clients and provide an affirming space and services network through which adult and child survivors can receive the care that they need to process and heal from their trauma and author new life chapters free of violence.

Crossroads for Women

Since we were awarded the grant from AWGC, we have been really busy renovating our building, Crossroads Village, into a space that women from Albuquerque can use for many years to come. The funds from AWGC are being used for the Family Wing of Crossroads Village, which have undergone an extensive renovation that included removing structures from the old behavioral hospital that occupied this building in the past. The funds were also used to create a kid-friendly and safe area for the children of Crossroads Women. We plan to complete this area with a playground attached to the family wing in September.
